Outer Court - East Gate (East, North and South Gates are identical for both Inner and Outer courts Exception – outer court has seven steps, inner court has eight steps) Eze 40:6a Then came he unto the gate which looketh toward the east,	
Threshold	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eze 40:6c and measured the threshold of the gate, <i>which was one reed</i> broad; • Eze 40:6d and the other threshold <i>of the gate, which was one reed</i> broad. • Eze 40:7b and the threshold of the gate by the porch of the gate within <i>was one reed</i>.
Guardrooms	Eze 40:7 And <i>every little chamber</i> was <i>one reed</i> long, and <i>one reed</i> broad; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • and <i>between the little chambers</i> were <i>five cubits</i>; Eze 40:10a And the little chambers of the gate eastward <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • were three on this side, and three on that side; • they three were of one measure: Eze 40:12 The space also before the little chambers was <i>one cubit on this side</i> , and the space <i>was one cubit on that side</i> : and the little chambers were <i>six cubits on this side</i> , and <i>six cubits on that side</i> .
Gateway and Gate	Eze 40:11 And he measured the breadth of the entry of the gate , <i>ten cubits</i> ; and the length of the gate , <i>thirteen cubits</i> .
Windows	Eze 40:16a And <i>there were narrow windows</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • to the little chambers, • and to their posts within the gate round about, • and likewise to the arches: and <i>windows were round about inward</i> :
Overall Dimensions of the Gate	Eze 40:13 He measured then the gate from the roof of one little chamber to the roof of another : the breadth <i>was five and twenty cubits, door against door</i> . Eze 40:14b ...the post of the court round about the gate . Eze 40:15 And from the face of the gate of the entrance unto the face of the porch of the inner gate were <i>fifty cubits</i> .
Porch	Eze 40:8 He measured also the porch of the gate <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>within</i>, one reed. • Eze 40:9a Then measured he the porch of the gate, <i>eight cubits</i>; • Eze 40:9c and the porch of the gate <i>was inward</i>.
Side Pillars of the Porch	Eze 40:9b and the posts thereof, <i>two cubits</i> ; Eze 40:14a He made also posts of <i>threescore cubits</i> , Eze 40:10b they three were of one measure: (Note: 2 cubits X 2 cubits; verse 9) Eze 40:16b and upon <i>each post</i> were palm trees .
Stairway	Eze 40:6b went up the stairs thereof, (seven steps , Eze 40:22,26)
