## 2 Peter - KJV

## Greetings

#### 2Pe 1:1 Simon Peter,

a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ,

to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of **God and our Saviour Jesus** Christ:

2Pe 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,

## Our Divine Nature given by Christ

2Pe 1:3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

2Pe 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises:

 that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

## Confirm and Assure your Salvation

#### 2Pe 1:5

## And beside this, giving all diligence,

- add to your faith virtue;
- and to virtue knowledge;
- 2Pe 1:6 And to knowledge temperance [self-control];
- and to temperance patience;
- and to patience godliness;
- 2Pe 1:7 And to godliness brotherly kindness;
- and to brotherly kindness charity.

2Pe 1:8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2Pe 1:9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

## 2Pe 1:10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure:

- for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:
- 2Pe 1:11 For so [In this way] an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

## Diligence and Reminders

#### 2Pe 1:12 Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things,

- though ye know them,
- and be established in the present truth.
- 2Pe 1:13 Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by putting you in remembrance;
- 2Pe 1:14 Knowing that shortly I must put off this my tabernacle,
  - even as our Lord Jesus Christ hath shewed me.
- 2Pe 1:15 Moreover I will endeavour that ye may be able after my decease to have these things always in remembrance.

## We were Eywitnesses of Jesus

#### 2Pe 1:16

For <u>we have not followed cunningly devised fables</u>, when we made known unto you the **power** and **coming** of **our Lord Jesus Christ**, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty.

- 2Pe 1:17 For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- 2Pe 1:18 And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy
  mount.

## All Prophecy of Scripture is from God, not Humans

#### 2Pe 1:19

We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto <u>ye do well that ye take heed</u>, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

2Pe 1:20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation.

- 2Pe 1:21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man:
- but holy men of **God** spake *as they were* moved by **the Holy Ghost**.

## False Prophets and Teachers, past, present, and future And their followers who formerly repented but turned away

#### 2Pe 2:1

But there were **false prophets** also among the people, even as there shall be **false teachers** among you, who privily shall bring in **damnable heresies**, even denying **the Lord** that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

- 2Pe 2:2 And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of.
- 2Pe 2:3 And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you:

whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not.

2Pe 2:4 For if

God spared not the angels that sinned,

- but cast *them* down to **hell**,
- and delivered *them* into **chains of darkness**, to be reserved unto **judgment**;

#### 2Pe 2:5

And spared not the old world,

- but saved Noah the eighth *person*, a preacher of righteousness, (Note: Noah plus 3 sons, and their wives equals 8)
- bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

## 2Pe 2:6 And

turning **the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha** into ashes condemned *them* with an overthrow, making *them* an ensample [example] unto those that after should live ungodly;

- 2Pe 2:7 And delivered just [righteous] Lot,
  - o vexed with the filthy conversation [behavior] of the wicked:
  - o 2Pe 2:8 (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed *his* righteous soul from day to day with *their* unlawful deeds;)

## 2Pe 2:9 **The Lord** knoweth how to deliver **the godly** out of temptations,

and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished:

2Pe 2:10 But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government [authority].

Presumptuous are they, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities [angelic majesties].

2Pe 2:11 Whereas angels, which are greater in power and might, bring not railing accusation against them before **the Lord**.

### 2Pe 2:12 But these,

- as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed,
- speak evil of the things that they understand not;

and shall utterly perish in their own corruption;

2Pe 2:13 And shall receive the reward of unrighteousness,

- as they that count it pleasure to riot in the day time.
- Spots *they are* and blemishes,
- sporting themselves with their own deceivings

while they feast with you;

- 2Pe 2:14 Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin;
- beguiling unstable souls:
- an [a] heart they have exercised with covetous practices;
- cursed children:
- 2Pe 2:15 Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam *the son* of Bosor [Beor],
  - o who loved the wages of unrighteousness;
  - o 2Pe 2:16 But was rebuked for his iniquity:
    - the dumb ass [donkey] speaking with man's voice forbad [restrained] the madness of the prophet.

### 2Pe 2:17 These are

- wells without water.
- clouds that are carried with a tempest;

to whom the mist of darkness is reserved for ever.

2Pe 2:18 For when they speak great swelling words of vanity, they allure

- through the lusts of the flesh,
- *through much* wantonness,

those that were clean escaped from them who live in error.

2Pe 2:19a While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption:

# A far worse eternal punishment awaits those who turn away from the Lord after having first been saved

A reiteration of Ezekiel 18:24

2Pe 2:19b for

of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.

2Pe 2:20 For

**if after** they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of **the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ**, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

2Pe 2:21 For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known *it*, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.

2Pe 2:22 But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb,

THE DOG IS TURNED TO HIS OWN VOMIT AGAIN;	<b>Pro 26:11</b> As a dog returneth to his vomit, <i>so</i> a fool returneth to his folly.
	Total to his leng.

and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.

### REMEMBER WHAT WAS SPOKEN BY THE PROPHETS AND APOSTLES

**2Pe 3:1** This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in *both* which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance: 2Pe 3:2 That ye may be mindful of

- the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets,
- and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour:

## The Day of Christ's Return and Punishment of The World is delayed to allow more people to repent

#### 2Pe 3:3

Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers,

- walking after their own lusts,
- 2Pe 3:4 And saying,
  - Where is the promise of his coming?
  - o for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as *they were* from the beginning of the creation.

#### 2Pe 3:5 For

this they willingly are ignorant of,

- that by the word of God the heavens were of old,
- and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: 2Pe 3:6 Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:

## 2Pe 3:7 But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are

kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition [destruction] of ungodly men.

#### 2Pe 3:8 But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing,

that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

2Pe 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness;

but is longsuffering [patient] to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

## 2Pe 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night;

in the which

- the **heavens** shall pass away with a great noise,
- and the elements shall melt with fervent heat,
- the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

## 2Pe 3:11 Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be

- in all holy conversation and godliness,
- 2Pe 3:12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God,

### wherein

- the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved,
- and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

## 2Pe 3:13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

## Final Words

2Pe 3:14 Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him

- in peace,
- without spot, and blameless.
- 2Pe 3:15 And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation;

even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto

- vou:
- 2Pe 3:16 As also in all his epistles [letters],

speaking in them of these things;

- in which are some things hard to be understood,
- which they that are **unlearned and unstable** wrest, as *they do* also **the other scriptures**, unto their own destruction.
- 2Pe 3:17 Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware [be on your guard ] lest
  - ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness.
- 2Pe 3:18 But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

To **him** be glory both now and **for ever.** Amen.
