Introduction

Rev 1:1 The Revelation of **Jesus Christ**,

- which **God** gave unto **him**, to shew unto his **servants** things which must shortly [inside a brief space of time] come to pass;

and **he** sent and signified *it* by **his angel** unto **his servant John**:

Rev 1:2 Who bare record of

- **the word of God**,
- and of **the testimony** of **Jesus Christ**,
- and of all things that he saw.

Rev 1:3 **Blessed is**

- he that readeth,
- and **they that hear the words of this prophecy**,
- and **keep [heed]** those things which are **written therein**:

for **the time is at hand**.

Greetings to the Seven Churches in Asia

Note Asia-Minor is on the west coast of Turkey

Rev 1:4

John to **the seven churches which are in Asia**: **Grace** be unto you, and **peace**,

from **him**

- which is,
- and which was,
- and which is to come;

and from **the seven Spirits** which are before **his throne**;

Rev 1:5

And from **Jesus Christ**,

- *who is* the faithful witness,
- *and* the first begotten of the dead,
- and the prince of the kings of the earth.

Unto **him** *that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood*,

Rev 1:6 and He has made us <i>to be</i> a kingdom ^{G932} , priests to His God and Father ; (NASV)	Rev 1:6 And hath made us kings ^{G935} and priests unto God and his Father ; (KJV)
---	---

Note: The KJV and NASV are translating from different manuscripts.
to **him** *be* glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Rev 1:7 BEHOLD, HE COMETH WITH CLOUDS;

(Note: Referring to, not quoting Mark 6:2 , Daniel 7:13)

- and every eye shall see **him**, and they *also* which pierced **him**:
- and **all kindreds of the earth** shall wail because of **him**.

Even so, Amen.

Rev 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith **the Lord**, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

Jesus commands John to write a book about things already seen, which are,
and future events

Rev 1:9 I **John**, who also am your brother, and companion in **tribulation**, and in **the kingdom** and **patience** of **Jesus Christ**, was in **the isle that is called Patmos**, for

- **the word of God**,
- and for **the testimony of Jesus Christ**. (Note: the testimony is the spirit of Prophecy - Rev 19:10)

Rev 1:10 I was in **the Spirit** on **the Lord's day**, and heard behind me **a great voice**, as of a trumpet,

Rev 1:11 Saying,

I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last:

and, What thou seest, write in **a book**, and send *it* unto **the seven churches which are in Asia**;

- unto **Ephesus**,
- and unto **Smyrna**,
- and unto **Pergamos**,
- and unto **Thyatira**,
- and unto **Sardis**,
- and unto **Philadelphia**,
- and unto **Laodicea**.

Rev 1:12 And I turned to see **the voice** that spake with me.

And being turned, I saw **seven golden candlesticks**; (Note: which are **the seven churches** - Rev 1:20)

Rev 1:13 And in the midst of **the seven candlesticks** *one* like unto **the Son of man**,

- clothed with a garment down to the foot,
- and girt about the paps **{His breast}** with a golden girdle.
- Rev 1:14 **His head** and **his hairs** *were* white like wool, as white as snow;
- and **his eyes** *were* as a flame of fire;
- Rev 1:15 And **his feet** like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace;
- and **his voice** as the sound of many waters.
- Rev 1:16 And he had in **his right hand** **seven stars**: (Note: angels of **the seven churches** - Rev 1:20)
- and out of **his mouth** went a sharp twoedged sword:
- and his **countenance** *was* as the sun shineth in his strength.

Rev 1:17 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And **he** laid **his right hand** upon me, saying unto me, **Fear not**;

- **I am** the **first** and the **last**:
- Rev 1:18 *I am* **he that liveth**,
- and was dead; and, behold, I am **alive** for evermore, Amen;
- and have the keys of hell and of death.

Rev 1:19 Write the things

- which thou **hast** seen,
- and the things which **are**,
- and the things which **shall be** hereafter;

Rev 1:20 The mystery of **the seven stars** which thou sawest in my right hand, and **the seven golden candlesticks**.

- **The seven stars** are **the angels** of **the seven churches**:
- and **the seven candlesticks** which thou sawest are **the seven churches**.

Rev 2:1

Unto **the angel** of the church of **Ephesus** write;

These things saith

he that holdeth **the seven stars in his right hand**, who walketh in the midst of **the seven golden candlesticks**;

Rev 2:2

I know

- thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience,
- and how thou canst not bear them which are evil:
- and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars:
- **Rev 2:3** And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted.

Rev 2:4 **Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee,**

- because thou hast left thy first love. (Note: Their emphasis was on good works for works' sake and being correct rather than love of Christ and others.)

Rev 2:5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen,

and **repent**, and do the first works;

or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.

Rev 2:6 **But this thou hast**, that thou hatest **the deeds of the Nicolaitans**, which I also hate.

(See: The Apostolic Fathers with Justin Martyr and Irenaeus - Book 1, Chapter 26, Book 3 Chapter 11)

Rev 2:7 *He that hath an ear, let him hear what **the Spirit** saith unto **the churches**;*

To him that overcometh will I give to eat of **the tree of life**, which is in the midst of the paradise of **God**.

Rev 2:8

And unto **the angel** of the church in **Smyrna** write;

These things saith the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;

Rev 2:9

I know

- thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich)
- and *I know* the **blasphemy** of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but *are* the synagogue of **Satan**.

Rev 2:10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold,

- **the Devil** shall cast *some* of you into prison, that ye may be tried;
- and ye shall have **tribulation ten days**:

be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

Rev 2:11 *He that hath an ear, let him hear what **the Spirit** saith unto **the churches**;*

He that overcometh shall not be hurt of **the second death**.

Rev 2:12

And to **the angel** of the church in **Pergamos** write;

These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges;

Rev 2:13 **I know**

- thy works, and where thou dwellest, *even where **Satan's** seat [throne] is:*
- and thou holdest fast **my name**, and hast not denied my **faith**, even in those days wherein **Antipas** was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where **Satan** dwelleth.

Rev 2:14 **But I have a few things against thee,**

- because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of **Balaam**, who taught **Balac** to cast a stumblingblock before **the children of Israel**,
 - to eat things sacrificed unto idols,
 - and to commit fornication.
 Note: Teaching of Balaam - the view that Christians can—or even should—compromise their convictions for the sake of popularity, money, sexual gratification, or personal gain. It's the attitude that treats sin as "no big deal".
- Rev 2:15 So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate. (See: The Apostolic Fathers with Justin Martyr and Irenaeus - Book 1, Chapter 26, Book 3 Chapter 11)

Rev 2:16 **Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.**

Rev 2:17 *He that hath an ear, let him hear what **the Spirit** saith unto **the churches**;*

To **him that overcometh**

- will I give to eat of the hidden manna,
- and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth *it*.

Rev 2:18

And unto **the angel** of the church in **Thyatira** write;

These things saith

the **Son of God**, who hath **his eyes** like unto a flame of fire, and **his feet** *are* like fine brass;

Rev 2:19

I know

- thy works,
- and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works;
- and the last *to be* more than the first.

Rev 2:20

Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee,

- because thou sufferest that woman **Jezebel**, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce **my servants**
 - to commit fornication,
 - and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

Rev 2:21 And I gave her space to **repent** of her fornication; and she repented not.

Rev 2:22 **Behold,**

- will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.
- Rev 2:23 And I will kill her children with death;

and all the churches shall know that **I am he**

- which searcheth the reins [innermost minds] and hearts:
- and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

Rev 2:24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.

Rev 2:25 But that which ye have already hold fast till I come.

Rev 2:26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, TO HIM WILL I GIVE POWER OVER THE NATIONS:

Rev 2:27 AND HE SHALL RULE THEM WITH A ROD OF IRON; AS THE VESSELS OF A POTTER SHALL THEY BE BROKEN TO SHIVERS: even as I received of my Father.

Rev 2:28 And I will give him the morning star.

Rev 2:29 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Rev 3:1

And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write;

These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars;

I know

- thy works,
- that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.

Rev 3:2 Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God.

Rev 3:3 Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent.

If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.

Rev 3:4 Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for they are worthy.

Rev 3:5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

Rev 3:6 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

Rev 3:7

And to **the angel** of the church in **Philadelphia** write;

These things saith

he that is holy,

he that is true,

he that hath the key of **David**,

he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

Rev 3:8

I know

- thy works:

behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for

- thou hast a little strength,
- and hast kept **my word**,
- and hast not denied **my name**.

Rev 3:9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of **Satan**, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; **behold**, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.

Rev 3:10 **Because** thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from

the hour of testing, that <i>hour</i> which is about to come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell upon the earth. (NASV)	the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth. (KJV)

Rev 3:11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

Rev 3:12 **Him that overcometh**

will I make a pillar in **the temple of my God**, and he shall go no more out {from it};

and I will write upon him

- **the name of my God**,
- and the name of the city of my **God**, *which is* new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my **God**:
- and I will write upon him **my new name**.

Rev 3:13 *He that hath an ear*, let him hear what **the Spirit** saith unto *the churches*.

Rev 3:14

And unto **the angel** of the church of the **Laodiceans** write;

These things saith **the Amen**, the **faithful and true witness**, the **beginning** of the creation of **God**;

Rev 3:15 I know

- thy works,
- that thou art neither cold nor hot:

I would thou wert cold or hot.

Rev 3:16 **So then because** thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

Rev 3:17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

Rev 3:18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and **white raiment**, that thou mayest be clothed, and *that* the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

Rev 3:19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: **be zealous therefore, and repent.**

Rev 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock:
if any man hear **my voice**, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

Rev 3:21 To **him that overcometh** will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with **my Father** in [on] **his throne**.

Rev 3:22 *He that hath an ear*, let him hear what **the Spirit** saith unto *the churches*.

Rev 4:1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door *was* opened in heaven: and **the first voice** which I heard *was* as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and **I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.**

The throne of God and the twenty-four elders

Rev 4:2 And immediately I was in **the Spirit**: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and **one** sat on **the throne**. Rev 4:3 And **he** that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone:

and *there was* a **rainbow** round about **the throne**, in sight like unto an emerald.

Rev 4:4 And round about **the throne** *were* **four and twenty seats**: and upon the seats I saw **four and twenty elders** sitting, clothed in **white raiment**; and they had on their heads **crowns of gold**.

Rev 4:5 And out of **the throne** proceeded **lightnings** and **thunderings** and **voices**:

and *there were* **seven lamps of fire** burning before **the throne**, which are **the seven Spirits of God**.

Rev 4:6 a And before **the throne** *there was* **a sea of glass** like unto crystal:

Seraphim above the throne

Rev 4:6b and in the midst of **the throne**, and round about **the throne**, *were* **four beasts full of eyes** before and behind.

Seraphim	Cherubim	Cherubim
<p>Rev 4:7 And the first beast <i>was</i> like a lion,</p> <p>and the second beast like a calf,</p> <p>and the third beast had a face as a man,</p> <p>and the fourth beast <i>was</i> like a flying eagle.</p>	<p>Eze 10:14 And every one had four faces: the first face <i>was</i> the face of a cherub, and the second face <i>was</i> the face of a man, and the third the face of a lion,</p> <p>and the fourth the face of an eagle.</p>	<p>Eze 1:10 As for the likeness of their faces, they four had the face of a man, and the face of a lion, on the right side: and they four had the face of an ox on the left side;</p> <p>they four also had the face of an eagle.</p>

Note: Seraphim have six wings. Cherubim have four wings, Ezekiel has a discrepancy in its description of the cherubim when comparing chapters 1 and 10 though Ezekiel says they are the same cherubim.

<p>Rev 4:8 And the four beasts had each of them six wings about <i>him</i>;</p> <p>and <i>they were</i> full of eyes within:</p> <p>and they rest not day and night, saying, HOLY, HOLY, HOLY, LORD GOD ALMIGHTY, WHICH WAS, AND IS, AND IS TO COME.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;"> <p>Isa 6:2 Above it [Him] stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly.</p> <p>Isa 6:3 And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, <i>is</i> the LORD of hosts: the whole earth <i>is</i> full of his glory.</p> </div>	<p>Eze 10:21 Every one had four faces apiece, and every one four wings; and the likeness of the hands of a man <i>was</i> under their wings.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;"> <p>Eze 1:6 And every one had four faces, and every one had four wings.</p> </div> <p>Eze 10:12 And their whole body, and their backs, and their hands, and their wings, and the wheels, <i>were</i> full of eyes round about, <i>even</i> the wheels that they four had.</p>

The Lord is worshipped by The Seraphim and The 24 Elders

Rev 4:9 And when **those beasts** give glory and honour and thanks

- to **him that sat on the throne**,
- **who liveth for ever and ever**,

Rev 4:10 The **four and twenty elders**

- **fall down before him that sat on the throne**,
- and **worship him** that liveth for ever and ever,
- and **cast their crowns** before **the throne**, saying,

Rev 4:11 Thou art worthy, **O Lord**, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Note: **The throne** here is not analogous to the ark of the covenant and the mercy seat above which are two cherubim.

The Lamb of God worthy to break The Seven Seals

Rev 5:1 And I saw in the right hand of **him that sat on the throne** a **book**

- written within and on the backside,
- sealed with **seven seals**.

Rev 5:2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open **the book**, and to loose **the seals** thereof?

Rev 5:3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open **the book**, neither to look thereon.

Rev 5:4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read **the book**, neither to look thereon.

Rev 5:5 And **one of the elders** saith unto me, Weep not:

behold, **the Lion** of **the tribe of Juda [Judah]**, **the Root** of **David**, **hath prevailed [overcome]** to open **the book**, and to loose **the seven seals** thereof.

Rev 5:6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of **the throne** and of **the four beasts**, and in the midst of **the elders**, stood a **Lamb** as it had been slain,

- **having seven horns**
- and **seven eyes**, which are **the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth**.

(Note Isaiah 11:2, 28:6: the spirits of wisdom, understanding, counsel, strength, knowledge, the fear of the LORD, justice)

Rev 5:7 And **he** came and took **the book** out of **the right hand of him that sat upon the throne**.

Rev 5:8 And when **he** had taken **the book**, **the four beasts** and **four and twenty elders** fell down before **the Lamb**, having every one of them

- harps,
- and golden vials full of odours [**golden bowls full of incense**], which are the prayers of *saints*.

Note: Everyone who puts their faith in Jesus Christ is a saint. A true saint is not defined by the Vatican but God alone. The Vatican does not have the exclusive right to determine who qualifies for sainthood.

Rev 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying,

Thou art worthy to take **the book**, and to open **the seals** thereof:

<p>for Thou wast slain, and didst purchase for God with Thy blood</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>men</i> from every tribe and tongue and people and nation. • Rev 5:10 "<i>And Thou hast made them to be a kingdom and priests to our God; and they will reign upon the earth.</i>" <p>(NASV)</p>	<p>for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; • Rev 5:10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth. <p>(KJV)</p>

Rev 5:11

And I beheld, and I heard the voice of

- **many angels** round about **the throne**
- and **the beasts**
- and **the elders**:

and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;

Rev 5:12 Saying with a loud voice,

Worthy is **the Lamb** that was slain to receive

- power,
- and riches,
- and wisdom,
- and strength,
- and honour, and glory,
- and blessing.

Rev 5:13

And every creature which is

- in heaven,
- and on the earth,
- and under the earth,
- and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them,

heard I saying, [I heard saying,]

Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power,

be unto **him** that sitteth upon **the throne**, and unto **the Lamb** for ever and ever.

Rev 5:14 And **the four beasts** said, Amen.

And the **four and twenty elders** fell down and worshipped **him** that liveth for ever and ever.

THE BOOK'S SEVEN SEALS

The first seal - unspecified who will be conquered

Rev 6:1 And I saw when **the Lamb** opened **one of the seals**, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, **one of the four beasts** saying, Come and see.

Rev 6:2 And I saw, and behold

a **white horse**:

and **he that sat on** him [it] had a **bow**; and a crown was given unto him:

and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

The second seal - wars, murders

Rev 6:3 And when **he** had opened **the second seal**, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.

Rev 6:4 And there went out another **horse that was red**:

and *power* was given to **him that sat** thereon

- to take peace from the earth,
- and that they should kill one another:

and there was given unto **him** a **great sword**.

The third seal - food shortage and higher prices

Rev 6:5 And when **he** had opened **the third seal**, I heard **the third beast** say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a **black horse**;

and **he that sat on** him had a **pair of balances** in his hand.

Rev 6:6 And I heard a voice in the midst of **the four beasts** say,

A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and *see* thou hurt not the oil and the wine.

The fourth seal - sword, plague, famine, wild beasts

Rev 6:7 And when he had opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of **the fourth beast** say, Come and see.

Rev 6:8 And I looked,

and behold a **pale horse**:

and **his name that sat on** him was **Death**, and **Hell** followed with **him**.

And power was given unto **them** over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with **sword**, and with **hunger**, and with **death**, and with the **beasts** of the earth.

The fifth seal - Those who overcome much tribulation

Rev 6:9 And when **he** had opened **the fifth seal**, I saw under **the altar** **the souls of them** that were slain

- for **the word of God**,
- and for **the testimony which they held**:

Rev 6:10 And **they** cried with a loud voice, saying,

How long, **O Lord, holy and true**, dost **thou** not **judge** and **avenge** our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

Rev 6:11 And **white robes** were given unto every one of them;

and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet **for a little season**, until their **fellow servants** also and **their brethren**, that should be killed as they were, **should be fulfilled**.

The sixth seal - catastrophic renderings in the sky, heavens, earth, sea

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened **the sixth seal**, and, lo,

- there was a **great earthquake**;
- and the **sun became black** as sackcloth of hair,
- and the **moon became as blood**;
- **Rev 6:13** And **the stars of heaven fell unto the earth**, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.
- **Rev 6:14** And **the heaven [sky] departed as a scroll** when it is rolled together;
- and **every mountain and island were moved out of their places**.

Rev 6:15 And **the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man**, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

(Isaiah 2:19-21)

Rev 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of **him** that sitteth on **the throne**, and from **the wrath of the Lamb**:

Rev 6:17 For **the great day of his wrath is come**; and who shall be able to stand?

Isa 2:19 And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.

Isa 2:20 In that day a man shall cast his idols of silver, and his idols of gold, which they made *each one* for himself to worship, to the moles and to the bats;

Isa 2:21 To go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.

Four Angels to harm the earth and sea

Rev 7:1 And after these things I saw **four angels** standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

Rev 7:2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living **God**: and he cried with a loud voice to **the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea**,

The 144,000 male virgins - part 1 of 2

Rev 7:3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have *sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads*.

Rev 7:4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: *and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel*.

1. Rev 7:5 Of the tribe of Juda [**Judah**] were sealed twelve thousand.
2. Of the tribe of **Reuben** were sealed twelve thousand.
3. Of the tribe of **Gad** were sealed twelve thousand.
4. Rev 7:6 Of the tribe of **Aser** were sealed twelve thousand.
5. Of the tribe of **Nephtalim [Naphtali]** were sealed twelve thousand.
6. Of the tribe of **Manasses [Manasseh]** were sealed twelve thousand.
7. Rev 7:7 Of the tribe of **Simeon** were sealed twelve thousand.
8. Of the tribe of **Levi** were sealed twelve thousand.
9. Of the tribe of **Issachar** were sealed twelve thousand.
10. Rev 7:8 Of the tribe of **Zabulon [Zebulun]** were sealed twelve thousand.
11. Of the tribe of **Joseph** were sealed twelve thousand.
12. Of the tribe of **Benjamin** were sealed twelve thousand.

Note Gen 35:23 The sons of Leah;

- **Reuben**, Jacob's firstborn,
- and **Simeon**,
- and **Levi**,
- and **Judah**,
- and **Issachar**,
- and **Zebulun**:

Gen 35:24 The sons of Rachel;

- **Joseph**,
- and **Benjamin**:

Gen 35:25 And the sons of Bilhah, Rachel's handmaid;

- **Dan**,
- and **Naphtali**:

Gen 35:26 And the sons of Zilpah, Leah's handmaid;

- **Gad**,
- and **Asher**:

Note: The tribe of Dan is speculated to have been destroyed by God for their rebellion per Judges 18:30-31. Ephraim also is not mentioned in the 144,000.

Those who overcome much tribulation

Rev 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms [palm branches] in their hands;

Rev 7:10 And cried with a loud voice, saying,

Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.

Rev 7:11 And all the angels stood round

- about the throne,
- and about the elders
- and the four beasts,

and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God, Rev 7:12 Saying,

Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.

Rev 7:13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they? (Note white robes of fine linen: the righteous deeds of believers in Jesus - Rev 19:8)

Rev 7:14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me,

These are they

- which came out of great tribulation,
- and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Rev 7:15 Therefore

- are they before the throne of God,
- and serve him day and night in his temple:
- and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.
- Rev 7:16 They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more;
- neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat.

Rev 7:17 For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne

- shall feed them,
- and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters:

and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.

The seventh seal - seven angels with seven trumpets

Rev 8:1 And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour.

Rev 8:2 And I saw the seven angels which stood before God; and to them were given seven trumpets.

Rev 8:3 And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer;

- and there was given unto him much incense,
- that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints

upon the golden altar which was before the throne.

Rev 8:4 And the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand.

Rev 8:5 And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast it into the earth: and there were

- voices, and thunderings,
- and lightnings,
- and an earthquake.

Rev 8:6 And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

First Trumpet - Hail, Fire, Blood

Rev 8:7 **The first angel** sounded,

and there followed **hail and fire mingled with blood**, and they were cast upon the earth:

NASV adds - and a **third** of the earth **was burned up**,

- and the **third part** of trees **was burnt up**,
- and **all** green grass **was burnt up**.

Second Trumpet - Asteroid 1

Rev 8:8 And **the second angel** sounded,

and **as it were a great mountain burning with fire** was cast into the sea:

and the **third part** of the sea **became blood**;

- Rev 8:9 And the **third part** of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, **died**;
- and the **third part** of the ships **were destroyed**.

Third Trumpet - Asteroid 2

Rev 8:10 And **the third angel** sounded,

and there fell **a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp**, and it fell upon

the **third part** of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters;

Rev 8:11 And **the name of the star is called Wormwood**:

- and the **third part** of the waters **became wormwood**;
- and **many men died** of the waters, because they were made bitter.

Note: Wormwood - a state or source of bitterness or grief

Forth Trumpet - Sun, Moon, and Stars smitten by large heavenly bodies

Rev 8:12 And **the fourth angel** sounded,

- and the **third part** of the **sun** was **smitten**,
- and the **third part** of the **moon**,
- and the **third part** of the **stars**;

so as the **third part** of them was **darkened**,

- and the **day** **shone not** for a third part of it,
- and the **night** **likewise**.

Rev 8:13

And I beheld,

and heard an angel [Note NASV - eagle] flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice,

Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabitants of the earth

by reason of

the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!

Note

NASV Eagle G105

KJV Angel G32

The NASV and KJV are translating from different Greek manuscripts.

Fifth Trumpet - The first Woe - stinging locust torment lasting 5 months

Rev 9:1 And the fifth angel sounded,

and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: (see verse 11)

and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.

Rev 9:2 And he opened the bottomless pit;

and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace;
and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit.

Rev 9:3 And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth:
and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.

Rev 9:4 And it was commanded them that they should

- not hurt the grass of the earth,
- neither any green thing, neither any tree;
- but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads.

Rev 9:5 And to them it was given that they should not kill them,
but that they should be tormented five months:
and their torment was as the torment of a scorpion, when he striketh a man.

Rev 9:6 And in those days shall men seek death, and shall not find it; and shall desire to die, and death shall flee from them.

Rev 9:7 And the shapes of the locusts

- were like unto horses prepared unto battle;
- and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold,
- and their faces were as the faces of men.
- **Rev 9:8** And they had hair as the hair of women,
- and their teeth were as the teeth of lions.
- **Rev 9:9** And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron;

and the sound of their wings was as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle.

Rev 9:10 And they had tails like unto scorpions,
and there were stings in their tails:
and their power was to hurt men five months.

Rev 9:11 And they had a king over them, which is the angel of the bottomless pit,

- whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon,
- but in the Greek tongue hath his name Apollyon.

Rev 9:12

One woe is past;

and, behold, there come two woes more hereafter.

Sixth Trumpet - The second Woe - Four angels/horsemen with an army of 200 million kill 1/3 of mankind with the plagues of fire, smoke, and brimstone. The survivors do not repent.

Rev 9:13 And the sixth angel sounded,

and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

Rev 9:14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet,

Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

Rev 9:15 And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.

Rev 9:16 And the number of the army of the horsemen were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

Rev 9:17 And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them,

- {the riders} having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone:
- and the heads of the horses were as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.

Rev 9:18 By these three was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke, and by the brimstone, which issued out of their mouths.

Rev 9:19 For their [the horses] power is in their mouth, and in their tails: for their tails were like unto serpents, and had heads, and with them they do hurt.

Rev 9:20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands,

- that they should not worship devils,
- and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

Rev 9:21 Neither repented they of

- their murders,
- nor of their sorceries,
- nor of their fornication,
- nor of their thefts.

The little book

Rev 10:1 And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire:

Rev 10:2 And he had in his hand a little book open:

and he set his right foot upon the sea, and his left foot on the earth,

Rev 10:3 And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.

Rev 10:4 And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.

Rev 10:5 And **the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth** lifted up his hand to heaven,

Rev 10:6 And sware by

Him that liveth for ever and ever, WHO CREATED

- HEAVEN, AND THE THINGS THAT THEREIN ARE,
- AND THE EARTH, AND THE THINGS THAT THEREIN ARE,
- AND THE SEA, AND THE THINGS WHICH ARE THEREIN,

that there should be time no longer:

Rev 10:7 But **in the days of the voice of the seventh angel**, when he shall begin to sound,

the mystery of God should be finished, as **he** hath declared to **his servants the prophets**.

Note: mystery of God - the gospel available to both Jews and non-Jews

Rev 10:8 And the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said,

Go *and* take **the little book** which is open in the hand of **the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth**.

Rev 10:9 And I went unto **the angel**, and said unto **him**, Give me **the little book**.

And he said unto me,

Take *it*, and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.

Rev 10:10 And I took **the little book** out of **the angel's** hand, and ate it up;

and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

Rev 10:11 And he said unto me,

*Thou must prophesy again before many **peoples**, and **nations**, and **tongues**, and **kings**.*

Jerusalem to be tread upon for 42 months/1260 days

Note: A Jewish month in this context is 30 days

Rev 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod:

and **the angel** stood, saying,

Rise, and measure

- **the temple of God**,
- and **the altar**,
- and them that worship therein.

Rev 11:2 But **the court** which is without [outside] **the temple** leave out, and measure it not;

for it is given unto **the Gentiles**: and **the holy city** shall they tread under foot **forty and two months**.

Two powerful witnesses

Rev 11:3 And I will give *power* unto **my two witnesses**, and they shall prophesy **a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth.

Rev 11:4 These are **the two olive trees**, and **the two candlesticks** standing before **the God of the earth**.

Zec 4:11 Then answered I, and said unto him, What *are* **these two olive trees** upon the right *side* of **the candlestick** and upon the left *side* thereof?

Zec 4:12 And I answered again, and said unto him, What *be* **these two olive branches** which through the **two golden pipes** empty **the golden oil** out of themselves?

Zec 4:13 And he answered me and said, Knowest thou not what these *be*? And I said, No, my lord.

Zec 4:14 Then said he, These *are* **the two anointed ones**, that stand by **the Lord of the whole earth**.

Rev 11:5 And if any man will [desires to] hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their **enemies**: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

Rev 11:7 And when they shall have finished **their testimony**, **the beast** that ascendeth out of **the bottomless pit** shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies *shall lie* in the street of **the great city**, which spiritually is called **Sodom and Egypt**, **where also our Lord was crucified**.

Rev 11:9 And they of **the people** and **kindreds** and **tongues** and **nations** shall see their dead bodies **three days and an half**, and shall not suffer [permit] their dead bodies to be put in graves.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because **these two prophets** tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

Rev 11:11 And **after three days and an half the Spirit** of life from **God** entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

Rev 11:12 And they heard **a great voice from heaven** saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.

Rev 11:13 And **the same hour** was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of **the city** fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the **God** of heaven.

Rev 11:14

The second woe is past; *and*, behold, the third woe cometh quickly.

The seventh trumpet - The third Woe - Lightning, Earthquake, Hailstorm

Rev 11:15 And **the seventh angel** sounded;

and there were **great voices in heaven**, saying,

The kingdoms of this world
are become *the kingdoms* of our Lord, and of his **Christ**;
and **he** shall reign for ever and ever.

Rev 11:16 And the **four and twenty elders**, which sat before **God** on their seats, **fell upon their faces, and worshipped God**,

Rev 11:17 Saying,

We give thee thanks, **O Lord God Almighty**,
which art, and wast, and art to come;
because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

Rev 11:18 And the **nations** were angry, and thy wrath is come,

and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest

give reward unto

- **thy servants the prophets,**
 - **and to the saints,**
 - **and them that fear thy name,**
- small and great;**

and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.

Rev 11:19 And **the temple of God** was opened in heaven,
and there was seen in his temple **the ark of his testament**:
and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings,
and an earthquake,
and great hail.

The great dragon (Satan) attempts to kill Mary, pregnant with Jesus

Rev 12:1 And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; **a woman**

- clothed with the sun,
- and the moon under her feet,
- and upon her head a crown of twelve stars:
- Rev 12:2 And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.

Rev 12:3 And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold **a great red dragon**,

- having **seven heads and ten horns**,
- and seven crowns upon his heads.
- Rev 12:4 And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth:

and **the dragon** stood before **the woman** which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

Rev 12:5 And she brought forth **a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron**: and her child was caught up unto **God**, and *to* his throne.

Rev 12:6 And **the woman** fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of **God**, that they should feed her there **a thousand two hundred and threescore days**.

The great dragon (Satan) is thrown down to earth

Rev 12:7 And there was war in heaven: **Michael and his angels** fought against **the dragon**;
and **the dragon** fought and his angels,

Rev 12:8 And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven.

Rev 12:9 And **the great dragon** was cast out,

- that old serpent, called **the Devil**, and **Satan**,
- which deceiveth the whole world:

he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Rev 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven,

Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ:

for **the accuser of our brethren** is cast down,
which accused them before our **God** day and night.

Rev 12:11

And they overcame him

- by **the blood of the Lamb**,
- and by **the word of their testimony**;
- and **they loved not their lives unto the death**.

Rev 12:12 Therefore **rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them**.

Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for **the Devil** is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but **a short time**.

The great dragon (Satan) further attempts to kill Mary

Rev 12:13 And when **the dragon** saw that **he was cast unto the earth**, he persecuted **the woman** which brought forth **the man child**.

Rev 12:14 And to **the woman** were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for **a time, and times, and half a time** (Note: 1260 days) , from the face of **the serpent**.

Rev 12:15 And **the serpent** cast out of his mouth water as a flood after **the woman**, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood. (Note: Herod's army slaying all males age 2 and under)

Rev 12:16 And the earth helped **the woman**, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which **the dragon** cast out of his mouth.

The great dragon (Satan) makes war on the saints

Rev 12:17 And **the dragon** was wroth with **the woman**, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed,

- which keep the commandments of **God**,
- and have **the testimony** of **Jesus Christ**.

The first beast - coming out of the sea

Rev 13:1 And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a **beast** rise up out of the sea, having **seven heads and ten horns**,

- and upon his **horns** ten crowns,
- and upon his **heads** the name of blasphemy.

Rev 13:2 And **the beast** which I saw was like unto a **leopard**,

- and his feet were as *the feet* of a **bear**,
- and his mouth as the mouth of a **lion**:

and **the dragon** gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

Rev 13:3 And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed:

and all the world wondered after the beast.

Rev 13:4 And they worshipped **the dragon** which gave power unto **the beast**: and they worshipped **the beast**, saying, Who *is* like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?

Rev 13:5 And there was given unto him

- a mouth speaking great things and **blasphemies**;
- and power was given unto him to continue **forty and two months**. (Note: 1260 days)

Rev 13:6 And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against **God**, to blaspheme

- **his name**,
- and **his tabernacle**,
- and **them** that dwell in heaven.

Rev 13:7 And it was given unto **him**

- to make war with **the saints**, and to overcome them:
- and power was given **him** over all **kindreds**, and **tongues**, and **nations**.

Rev 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him,

- whose names are not written in **the book of life** of **the Lamb** slain from the foundation of the world.

Rev 13:9 If any man have an ear, let him hear.

Rev 13:10 He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity:
he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword.

*Here is the **patience [perseverance]** and the **faith** of **the saints**.*

The second beast - False Prophet - coming up out of the earth

Rev 13:11 And I beheld **another beast** coming up out of the earth:

- and he had **two horns** like a lamb,
- and he spake as a dragon.

Rev 13:12 And he exercises <u>all the authority of the first beast</u> in his presence. (NASV)	Rev 13:12 And he exerciseth <u>all the power of the first beast</u> before him, (KJV)
--	---

and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

Rev 13:13 And **he doeth great wonders**,

- so that he maketh fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men,

Rev 13:14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by *the means of* those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the {first} beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make **an image to the beast**, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.

Rev 13:15 And he had power to give life unto **the image of the beast**, that the image of the beast should both

- speak,
- and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

Note: The first beast deliberately mocks Psalm 115:5-8 by giving “life” to carved images.

Rev 13:16 And he causeth all,

- both small and great,
- rich and poor,
- free and **bond**,

to receive **a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads**:

Rev 13:17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark,

- or [either] **the name of the beast**,
- or **the number of his name**.

Rev 13:18 Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count **the number of the beast**:

- for it is the number of a man;
- and his number *is* Six hundred threescore and six. Note: 666

Note: Today’s technologies involving bar codes, embedded microchips/microprocessors/nano-technology could very well apply here. Also the mark on the hand could be one’s works and the mark on the head could be one’s mind.

Note: The number, 666, is the number of the first/sea beast. The second/land beast is the false prophet of Revelation 19:20.

The 144,000 male virgins - part 2 of 2

Rev 14:1 And I looked, and, lo, a **Lamb** stood on **the mount Sion [Zion]**,

and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His name and the name of His Father written on their foreheads . (NASV)	and with him an hundred forty <i>and</i> four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads . (KJV)
--	---

Note Rev 3:12 - Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in **the temple** of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, *which is new Jerusalem*, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and *I will write upon him* my new name.

Rev 14:2 And I heard a voice from heaven,

- as the voice of many waters,
- and as the voice of a great thunder:

and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps:

Rev 14:3 And they sung as it were a new song

- before **the throne**,
- and before **the four beasts**, and **the elders**:

and no man could learn that song but **the hundred and forty and four thousand**, which were redeemed from the earth.

- Rev 14:4 These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins.
- **These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth.**
- **These were redeemed** from among men, *being* the firstfruits unto **God** and to **the Lamb**.
- Rev 14:5 And **in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault** before **the throne** of **God**.

An angel preaches the gospel

Rev 14:6 And I saw **another angel** fly in the midst of heaven, having **the everlasting gospel to preach**

- unto them that dwell on the earth,
- and to every **nation**, and **kindred**, and **tongue**, and **people**,

Rev 14:7 Saying with a loud voice,

Fear **God**, and **give glory to him**;
for **the hour of his judgment is come**;
and worship **him** that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

A second angel declares Babylon has fallen

Rev 14:8 And there followed **another angel**, saying,

Babylon is fallen, is fallen, **that great city**,

she who has made all the **nations** drink of the wine of the passion of her immorality. (NASV)

because she made all **nations** drink of the wine of **the wrath of** her fornication. (KJV)

A third angel declares the consequences to those who worship and take the mark of the second beast

Rev 14:9 And **the third angel** followed them, saying with a loud voice,

If any man worship **the beast** and his **image**,
and receive **his mark** in his forehead, or in his hand,

Rev 14:10 The same shall drink of the wine of **the wrath of God**,
which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation;
and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone

in the presence of the holy angels,

and in the presence of **the Lamb**:

Rev 14:11 And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever:
and they have **no rest** day nor night,

who worship **the beast and his image**, and whosoever receiveth **the mark of his name**.

Rev 14:12

*Here is the **patience** of **the saints**: here are they that keep
the commandments of **God**,*

*and **their faith** in **Jesus**. (NASV)*

*and the **faith** of **Jesus**. (KJV)*

Rev 14:13 And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write,

Blessed *are* the dead which die in **the Lord** from henceforth:

Yea, saith **the Spirit**,

that they may **rest** from their labours; and **their works** do follow them.

The harvest of the Righteous

Rev 14:14 And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud *one* sat like unto **the Son of man**,

- having on his head a golden crown,
- **and in his hand a sharp sickle.**

Rev 14:15 And **another angel** came out of **the temple**, crying with a loud voice to **him that sat on the cloud**,

Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for **the time is come for thee to reap**; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.

Rev 14:16 And **he that sat on** the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped.

The wicked crushed in the winepress of God's wrath

Rev 14:17 And **another angel** came out of **the temple** which is in heaven,

- **he also having a sharp sickle.**

Rev 14:18 And **another angel came out from the altar**, which had power over fire;

and cried with a loud cry to **him that had the sharp sickle**, saying,

Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

Rev 14:19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast *it* into **the great winepress of the wrath of God**.

Rev 14:20 And the winepress was trodden without the city,

and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand *and* six hundred furlongs [200 miles].

Victors over the beast sing The Song of Moses and The Song of the Lamb

Rev 15:2 And I saw as it were **a sea of glass mingled with fire**:

and **them that had gotten the victory**

- over **the beast**,
- and over **his image**,
- and over **his mark**,
- *and* over **the number of his name**,

stand on **the sea of glass**, having the harps of **God**.

Rev 15:3

And **they** sing

- **the song of Moses the servant of God**,
- and **the song of the Lamb**,

saying,

Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty;

Righteous and true are Thy ways, Thou King of the nations . (NASV)	just and true <i>are</i> thy ways, thou King of saints . (KJV)
---	---

Rev 15:4 Who shall not fear thee, **O Lord**, and glorify **thy name?**

for *thou only art* holy:

FOR ALL **NATIONS** SHALL COME AND WORSHIP BEFORE THEE;

FOR **THY JUDGMENTS ARE MADE MANIFEST**.

Note: Closest references are Psalm 22:27, 86:9-10. This is not a quote but a reference.

Note: The Song of Moses is found in Exodus 32.

No Old Testament reference is found for "**the Song of the Lamb**".

Seven angels given seven bowls to pour out seven plagues

Rev 15:1 And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues ;	because in them the wrath of God is finished. (NASV)	for in them is filled up the wrath of God . (KJV)
---	---	--

Rev 15:5 And after that I looked, and, behold, **the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony** in heaven was opened:

Rev 15:6 And **the seven angels** came out of **the temple**,

- having **the seven plagues**,
- clothed in pure and white linen,
- and having their breasts girded with golden girdles.

Rev 15:7 And **one of the four beasts** gave unto **the seven angels seven golden vials** full of **the wrath of God**, who liveth for ever and ever.

Rev 15:8 And **the temple** was filled with smoke from **the glory of God**, and from **his power**; and no man was able to enter into **the temple**, till **the seven plagues** of **the seven angels** were fulfilled.

Rev 16:1 And I heard a great voice out of **the temple** saying to **the seven angels**, Go your ways, and pour out **the vials of the wrath of God** upon the earth.

First bowl of wrath - malignant boils on those with the mark of the beast

Rev 16:2 And **the first** went, and poured out his vial upon **the earth**;

and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon

- the men which had **the mark of the beast**,
- and *upon* them which worshipped **his image**.

Second Bowl of wrath - sea of blood

Rev 16:3 And **the second angel** poured out his vial upon **the sea**;

and it became as the blood of a dead *man*:
and every living soul died in the sea.

Third bowl of wrath - rivers and springs of blood

Rev 16:4 And **the third angel** poured out his vial upon **the rivers and fountains of waters**;

and they became blood.

Rev 16:5

And I heard **the angel of the waters** say,

Thou art righteous, **O Lord**, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because **thou** hast judged thus.

Rev 16:6 For they have shed the blood **of saints and prophets**, and thou hast given them blood to drink; for they are worthy {of it}.

Rev 16:7

And I heard **another out of the altar** say,

Even so, **Lord God Almighty**, true and righteous *are thy* judgments.

Forth bowl of wrath - solar flares hit earth

Rev 16:8 And **the fourth angel** poured out his vial upon **the sun**;

and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire.

Rev 16:9 And men were scorched with great heat,
and blasphemed **the name of God**, which hath power over **these plagues**:
and they repented not to give **him** glory.

Fifth bowl of wrath - biological plague on the kingdom of the beast

Rev 16:10 And **the fifth angel** poured out his vial upon **the seat of the beast**;

and his kingdom was full of darkness;
and they gnawed their **tongues** for pain,

Rev 16:11 And blasphemed **the God of heaven** because of their pains and their sores,
and repented not of their deeds.

Sixth bowl of wrath - HarMagedon set-up

Rev 16:12 And **the sixth angel** poured out his vial upon **the great river Euphrates**;

and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of **the kings of the east** might be prepared.

Rev 16:13

And I saw **three unclean spirits like frogs** *come* out of

- the mouth of **the dragon**,
- and out of the mouth of **the beast**,
- and out of the mouth of **the false prophet**.

Rev 16:14 For they are **the spirits of devils**,

- working miracles,
- *which* go forth unto the kings of **the earth** and of **the whole world**, to gather them to **the battle of that great day of God Almighty**.

Rev 16:16 And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue **Armageddon**.

Note: **Jer 46:10** For this *is* the day of the Lord GOD of hosts, a day of vengeance, that he may avenge him of his adversaries: and the sword shall devour, and it shall be satiate and made drunk with their blood: for the Lord GOD of hosts hath a sacrifice in the north country by the river Euphrates.

Note: The Euphrates flows from Syria through Iraq into the Persian Gulf.

Rev 16:15 Behold, **I come as a thief**.

Blessed *is* he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments,
lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.

Seventh bowl of wrath - great earthquake, rearrangement of geography, huge hailstones, Babylon is destroyed

Rev 16:17 And **the seventh angel** poured out his vial into the air;
and there came a great voice out of **the temple** of heaven, from **the throne**, saying, It is done.

Rev 16:18 And there were

- voices, and thunders,
- and lightnings;
- and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, *and* so great.

Rev 16:19 And **the great city** was divided into three parts,

and **the cities of the nations** fell:

and **great Babylon** came in remembrance before **God**,
to give unto her the cup of the wine of **the fierceness of his wrath**.

Rev 16:20 And **every island** fled away,
and **the mountains** were not found.

Rev 16:21 And there fell upon men a **great hail** out of heaven, *every stone* about the weight of a talent [100 pounds]:
and men blasphemed **God** because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

The great harlot on the scarlet 666 sea beast

Rev 17:1 And there came one of **the seven angels** which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee **the judgment of the great whore** that sitteth upon **many waters** (see verse 15):

Rev 17:2 With whom **the kings of the earth** have committed fornication,
and **the inhabitants of the earth** have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.

Rev 17:3 So he carried me away in **the Spirit** into the wilderness:

and I saw **a woman** sit upon **a scarlet coloured beast**, (See 1 Kings 16-21, 2 Kings 9 relating to Jezebel)

- full of names of blasphemy,
- having **seven heads and ten horns**.

Rev 17:4 And **the woman**

- was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour,
- and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls,
- having **a golden cup** in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:

Rev 17:5 And upon her forehead *was* a name written, **mystery, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH**.

Rev 17:6 And I saw **the woman** drunken

- with the blood of **the saints**,
- and with the blood of **the martyrs [witnesses] of Jesus**:

and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration [I wondered greatly].

Rev 17:7 And **the angel** said unto me, Wherefore didst thou marvel?

I will tell thee the mystery

- of **the woman**,
- and of **the beast** that carrieth her, which hath **the seven heads and ten horns**.

The first beast, from the sea, 666
 Its 7 heads and 10 horns are kings
 It is the eighth king

Rev 17:8 **The beast** that thou sawest

- was, and is not;
- and shall ascend out of **the bottomless pit**, and go into perdition:

and **they that dwell on the earth** shall wonder, whose names were not written in **the book of life from the foundation of the world**,

when they behold **the beast**

- that was,
- and is not,
- and yet is.

Rev 17:9 And here *is* the mind which hath wisdom.

The seven heads are **seven mountains**, on which **the woman** sitteth. Rev 17:10 And there [they] are **seven kings**:

- **five** are fallen,
- **and** one is,
- *and the other* is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space.

Rev 17:11 And **the beast**

- that was,
- and is not,

even he is **the eighth**, and is **of the seven**,
 and goeth into perdition.

Rev 17:12 And the **ten horns** which thou sawest are **ten kings**,

- which have received no kingdom as yet;
- but receive power as kings **one hour** with **the beast**.
- Rev 17:13 These have one mind [purpose], and shall give their power and strength unto the beast.

Rev 17:14 These shall make war with **the Lamb**,

and **the Lamb** shall overcome them: for

- **he is Lord** of lords, and **King** of kings:
- **and they that are with him** are called, and **chosen**, and **faithful**.

The people of earth turn against the harlot of Babylon

Rev 17:15 And he saith unto me, **The waters** which thou sawest, where **the whore** sitteth,

- are **peoples**, and **multitudes**, and **nations**, and **tongues**.

Rev 17:16 And **the ten horns** which thou sawest upon **the beast**,

- these shall hate **the whore**,
- and shall make her desolate and naked,
- and shall eat her flesh,
- and burn her with fire.

Rev 17:17 For **God** hath put in their hearts

- to fulfil his will,
 - and to agree, and give their kingdom unto the beast,
- until the words of **God** shall be fulfilled.

Rev 17:18 And **the woman** which thou sawest **is that great city**, which reigneth over **the kings of the earth**.

Once a prosperous Babylon
Now a prison for demons and the powerful wicked

Rev 18:1 And after these things I saw **another angel come down from heaven, having great power;** and the earth was lightened with his glory.

Rev 18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying,

Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen,
and is become

- **the habitation** of devils,
- and **the hold [G5438: prison]** of every foul spirit,
- and **a cage [G5438: prison]** of every unclean and hateful bird.

Rev 18:3 For

- **all nations** have drunk of the wine of **the wrath** of her fornication,
- and **the kings of the earth** have committed fornication with her,
- and **the merchants of the earth** are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

Come out from Babylon, my people, and avoid the pending torment

Rev 18:4 And I heard **another voice from heaven,** saying,

Come out of her, my people,
that ye be not partakers of **her sins,**
and that ye receive not of **her plagues.**

Rev 18:5 For **her sins** have reached unto heaven,
and **God** hath remembered her iniquities.

Rev 18:6 Reward her even as she rewarded you,
and double unto her double according to her works:
in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double.

Rev 18:7 How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously,
so much torment and sorrow give her:

Rev 18:7b for she saith in her heart,
I sit a queen,

and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.

Rev 18:8 Therefore shall **her plagues** come **in one day,**
death, and **mourning;** and **famine;**
and she shall be utterly **burned with fire:**
for strong **is the Lord God** who judgeth her.

Isa 47:7 And thou saidst, I shall be a lady for ever: *so*
that thou didst not lay these *things* to thy heart, neither
didst remember the latter end of it.

Isa 47:8 Therefore hear now this, *thou that art* given to
pleasures, that dwellest carelessly, that sayest in thine
heart, I *am,* and none else beside me; I shall not sit *as* a
widow, neither shall I know the loss of children:

Isa 47:9-15 - Punishment for many acts of witchcraft

Those who got rich off Babylon lament her destruction

Rev 18:9 And **the kings of the earth,**

- who have committed fornication
- and lived deliciously [sensuously] with her,

shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see **the smoke of her burning,**

Rev 18:10 Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying,

Alas, alas, **that great city Babylon, that mighty city!**

For **in one hour** is thy judgment come.

Rev 18:11 And the merchants of the earth shall weep and mourn over her; for no man buyeth their merchandise any more:

Rev 18:12 The merchandise of

- gold, and silver,
- and precious stones, and of pearls,
- and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet,
- and all thyine wood,
- and all manner vessels of ivory,
- and all manner vessels of most precious wood,
- and of brass, and iron, and marble,
- Rev 18:13 And cinnamon, and odours,
- and ointments, and frankincense,
- and wine, and oil,
- and fine flour, and wheat,
- and beasts, and sheep,
- and horses, and chariots,
- **and slaves, and souls of men.**

Rev 18:14 And the fruits that thy soul lusted after are departed from thee, and all things which were dainty and goodly are departed from thee, and thou shalt find them no more at all.

Rev 18:15 The merchants of these things, which were made rich by her, shall stand afar off for the fear of her torment, weeping and wailing,

Rev 18:16 And saying,

Alas, alas, that great city,
that was clothed in fine linen, and purple, and scarlet,
and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls!

Rev 18:17 For in one hour so great riches is come to nought.

And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off,

Rev 18:18 And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying,

What city is like unto this great city!

Rev 18:19 And they cast dust on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing, saying,

Alas, alas, that great city,
wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness!
for in one hour is she made desolate.

Rev 18:20 Rejoice over her, thou heaven, and ye holy apostles and prophets; [NASV adds: and saints] for God hath avenged you on her.

Babylon totally destroyed forever

Rev 18:21 And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all.

Rev 18:22 And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpeters, shall be heard no more at all in thee;

and no craftsman, of whatsoever craft he be, shall be found any more in thee;

and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in thee;

Rev 18:23 And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee;

and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee:

for thy merchants were the great men of the earth;

for by thy sorceries were all nations deceived.

Rev 18:24 And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth.

Heaven rejoices over the destruction of Babylon

Rev 19:1 And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying,

Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God:

Rev 19:2 FOR TRUE AND RIGHTEOUS ARE HIS JUDGMENTS: (Psalm 19:9) for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, AND HATH AVENGED THE BLOOD OF HIS SERVANTS AT HER HAND. (Deu 32:43)

Psa 19:9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.

Deu 32:43 Rejoice, O ye nations, with his people: for he will avenge the blood of his servants, and will render vengeance to his adversaries, and will be merciful unto his land, and to his people.

Rev 19:3 And again they said,

Alleluia. And her smoke rose up for ever and ever.

Giving praise to God

Rev 19:4 And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying,

Amen; Alleluia.

Rev 19:5 And a voice came out of the throne, saying,

Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great.

Rev 19:6 And I heard as it were

- the voice of a great multitude,
- and as the voice of many waters,
- and as the voice of mighty thunderings,

saying,

Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth.

The Marriage Supper of the Lamb

Rev 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

Rev 19:8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white:

- for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

Rev 19:9 And he saith unto me,

Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb.

And he saith unto me,

These are the true sayings of **God**.

Rev 19:10 And I fell at his feet to worship him.

And he said unto me,

See *thou do it* not:

I am thy fellow**servant**, and of thy brethren that have **the testimony** of **Jesus**: worship **God**:

- for **the testimony** of **Jesus** is **the Spirit** of **prophecy**.

The army of Jesus on white horses

Rev 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a **white horse**;
and **he that sat upon** him

- *was* called **Faithful** and **True**,
- and in righteousness **he** doth judge and make war.
- Rev 19:12 **His eyes** *were* as a flame of fire,
- and on **his head** *were* many crowns;
- and **he had a name written**, that no man knew, but he himself.
- Rev 19:13 And **he was clothed** with a vesture dipped in blood:
- and **his name** is called **The Word of God**. (see John 1:1)

Rev 19:14 And **the armies which were in heaven** followed him upon **white horses**, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

Rev 19:15 And out of **his mouth** goeth a sharp sword, *that with it he should smite the nations*:
and he shall rule them with a rod of iron:

and he treadeth the winepress of **the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God**.

Rev 19:16 And he hath on **his vesture [robe]** and on **his thigh** a name written, **KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS**.

The wicked in power are fed to the birds

The beast and false prophet are thrown into the lake of fire

Rev 19:17 And I saw **an angel** standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven,

Come and gather yourselves together unto **the supper of the great God**;

Rev 19:18 That ye may eat

- the flesh of **kings**,
- and the flesh of **captains**,
- and the flesh of **mighty men**,
- and the flesh of horses, and of **them that sit on them**,
- and the flesh of **all men**, *both free and bond, both small and great*.

Rev 19:19 And I saw **the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies**, gathered together to make war

- against **him** that sat on **the horse**,
- and against **his army**.

Rev 19:20 And **the beast** was taken, and with him **the false prophet** that wrought miracles before him,

- with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image.

These both were cast alive into **a lake of fire burning with brimstone**.

Rev 19:21 And **the remnant** were slain with the sword of **him that sat upon the horse**, which *sword* proceeded out of **his** mouth:

and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Satan is bound for a thousand years

Rev 20:1 And I saw **an angel** come down from heaven,

- having the key of **the bottomless pit**
- and a great chain in his hand.

Rev 20:2 And he laid hold on **the dragon, that old serpent**, which is **the Devil**, and **Satan**, and bound him **a thousand years**,

Rev 20:3 And cast him into **the bottomless pit**, and shut him up,

and set a seal upon him,

that he should deceive the **nations** no more, **till the thousand years should be fulfilled**:

and after that he must be loosed **a little season**.

The first resurrection

The thousand year reign and priesthood of those who refuse the mark of the beast

Rev 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them:

and *I saw* **the souls of them that were beheaded**

- for **the witness [testimony] of Jesus**, (Note: which is the Spirit of prophecy - Rev 19:10)
- and for **the word of God**,
- and which had not worshipped **the beast**, neither **his image**,
- neither had received **his mark** upon their foreheads, or in their hands;

and they lived and reigned with **Christ a thousand years**.

Rev 20:5 But **the rest of the dead** lived not again **until the thousand years were finished**.

This is the first resurrection.

Rev 20:6 **Blessed** and **holy** *is* he that hath part in the first resurrection:

on such **the second death** hath no power,

but they shall be **priests** of **God** and of **Christ**,

and shall reign with **him a thousand years**.

At the completion of the thousand years

Another invasion against the saints is thwarted by God

Rev 20:7 And **when the thousand years are expired**,

Satan shall be loosed out of **his prison**,

Rev 20:8 And shall go out to deceive **the nations** which are in the four quarters of the earth, **Gog and Magog**, to gather them together to battle:

the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.

Rev 20:9 And they went up on the breadth [plain] of the earth,

and compassed [surrounded] **the camp of the saints** about, and **the beloved city**:

and fire came down from **God** out of heaven, and devoured them.

(See Ezekiel 38-39)

Satan joins the beast and false prophet who are already in the lake of fire

Rev 20:10 And **the Devil** that deceived them was cast into **the lake of fire and brimstone**, where **the beast and the false prophet** are, and shall be tormented **day and night for ever and ever**.

Judgment Before the Great White Throne

Rev 20:11 And I saw a **great white throne**,
and him that sat on it,
from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

Rev 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before **God**;
and **the books** were opened:
and **another book** was opened, which is *the book of life*:

and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in **the books**, according to their works.

Rev 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it;
and **death** and **hell** delivered up the dead which were in them:

and they were judged every man according to their works.

The Second Death - Lake of Fire

Rev 20:14 And **death** and **hell** were cast into the lake of fire.

This is the second death.

Rev 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in **the book of life** was cast into **the lake of fire**.

New Heaven, New Earth, New Jerusalem

Rev 21:1

And I saw **a new heaven and a new earth**:

- for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away;
- and there was no more sea.

Rev 21:2 And I **John** saw **the holy city, new Jerusalem**,

- coming down from **God** out of heaven,
- prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Promises

Rev 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying,

Behold, **the tabernacle of God** is with men,
and **he** will dwell with them,
and they shall be **his** people,
and **God himself** shall be with them, *and be their God*.

Rev 21:4 And **God** shall wipe away all tears from their eyes;
and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying,
neither shall there be any more pain:
for the former things are passed away.

Rev 21:5 And **he that sat upon the throne** said,
Behold, I make all things new.

And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.

Rev 21:6 And **he** said unto me,
It is done.

I am Alpha and Omega,
the beginning and the end.

I will give unto **him that is athirst** of the fountain of the water of life freely.

Rev 21:7 **He that overcometh** shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

Those who will not live in the New Jerusalem

Rev 21:8 But the **fearful**, and **unbelieving**, and the **abominable**, and **murderers**, and **whoremongers**, and **sorcerers**, and **idolaters**, and **all liars**, shall have their part in **the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.**

Come see the New Jerusalem

Rev 21:9 And there came unto me **one of the seven angels** which had **the seven vials full of the seven last plagues**, and talked with me, saying,
Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, **the Lamb's** wife.

Rev 21:10 And he carried me away in **the Spirit** to a great and high mountain, and shewed me **that great city, the holy Jerusalem**,

- descending out of heaven from **God**,
- Rev 21:11 Having **the glory of God**:
- and her light *was* like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

12 Gates of Pearl => 12 tribes of Israel

Rev 21:12

And had a wall great and high, *and* had **twelve gates**,
and at the gates twelve angels,
and names written thereon, which are *the names* of **the twelve tribes of the children of Israel**:

- Rev 21:13 On the east three gates;
- on the north three gates;
- on the south three gates;
- and on the west three gates.

Rev 21:21a And the twelve gates *were* twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl:

12 Foundation Stones => 12 Apostles

Rev 21:14

And the wall of the city had twelve foundations,

- and in them **the names of the twelve apostles** of **the Lamb**.

Jerusalem's measurements overview

Rev 21:15 And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure

- the city,
- and the gates thereof,
- and the wall thereof.

Rev 21:16 And the city lieth foursquare,

- and the length is as large as the breadth:
- and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. **Note: 1500 miles**
- The **length** and the **breadth** and the **height** of it **are equal**.

Rev 21:17 And he measured the wall thereof,

- **an hundred and forty and four cubits**, according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.

Building Materials - transparent gold and precious stones

Rev 21:18 And the building [material] of **the wall** of it was *of* **jasper**:

and **the city was pure gold**, like unto clear glass.

Rev 21:21b and **the street of the city was pure gold**, as it were transparent glass.

Rev 21:19 And **the foundations of the wall of the city were** garnished with all manner of precious stones.

Note: a stone for each of the twelve apostles per verse 14

- The first foundation *was* **jasper**;
- the second, **sapphire**;
- the third, a **chalcedony**;
- the fourth, an **emerald**;
- Rev 21:20 The fifth, **sardonyx**;
- the sixth, **sardius**;
- the seventh, **chrysolite**;
- the eighth, **beryl**;
- the ninth, a **topaz**;
- the tenth, a **chrysoprasus**;
- the eleventh, a **jacinth**;
- the twelfth, an **amethyst**.

Rev 21:22 And I saw **no temple** therein: for **the Lord God Almighty** and **the Lamb** are **the temple** of it.

Lighting

Rev 21:23 And the city had no need of the **sun**, neither of the **moon**, to shine in it:

for **the glory of God** did lighten it, and **the Lamb** *is* the light thereof.

Rev 21:24 And **the nations of them which are saved** shall walk in the light of it: and **the kings of the earth** do bring their glory and honour into it.
